Dear Parents and Caregivers,

To acknowledge 100 Days of School we are having a Science Technology Engineering Mathematics (STEM) Fun Day on Wednesday July 4. Students will have the opportunity to dress up and participate in some fun activities that celebrate the number 100.

Students are asked to come to school dressed up as someone or something to do with the number 100. Families are encouraged to make use of items around the house for accessories.

This can be as simple as wearing an item of clothing that has 100 sequins or a ribbon that is 100cm long. Some other suggestions might be to dress as a cricketer who has scored a century of 100 runs, a centenarian who is 100 years old or a Dalmatian dog that has 100 spots.

Each stage will participate in different activities integrating skills in Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM). This might include investigating what they can create with 100 craft sticks or designing a bridge to hold 100 counters. They will demonstrate critical thinking, communication, collaboration and creativity.

We can't wait to see what our students come up with!
