Dear parents and caregivers,

On **Thursday**, **29**<sup>th</sup> **March (week 9) at 12:00pm**, Glenwood Public School will be holding its Easter Hat Parade! Family and friends are more than welcome to attend.

#### **Parade**

Each K-2 class will parade and show off their hats, guided by their buddy class. ALL hats to be worn on the day will be created at school allowing for buddy classes to work together. This allows for our older students to have the opportunity to take on a responsible leader role. As usual, this is not a competition.

There will be an opportunity for younger siblings who are not a student at Glenwood Public School to parade their creations if they wish to make one at home. On the day students or parents will be given the opportunity to parade and help them. Parents are welcome to get creative too and join in the fun by also wearing a creative hat.

#### Hats

**K-2** students will make their hats at school with the help of their buddy class during weeks 10 and 11. Students in years 3-6 are more than welcome to make their own hat for the parade, however time given at school will be focused on working with their younger buddy to support them in making their hat.

The school will supply some items to use for decoration. Students can bring in objects, decorations, glue, tape, stickers and anything else they wish to use on their Easter Hats in a plastic bag labelled with their name. In addition to decorations, students can provide a piece of cardboard to be made into a hat or a plain basic store bought hat to decorate. Please write your child's name on cardboard or hat supplied.

### **Colouring Competition**

Students will be given the opportunity to participate in a colouring in competition with prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd awarded across each stage. An entry fee of \$1 is required to be considered. Money raised will go towards the prizes and towards projects selected by the Student Representative Council (SRC). Only one colouring sheet will be provided per student.

## **Guessing Competition**

The SRC will be running an Easter egg guessing competition at lunch and recess. Each guess is 20c with the winner announced after the parade.
