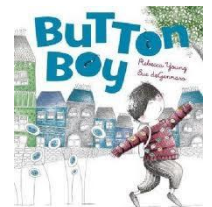
Sport News


