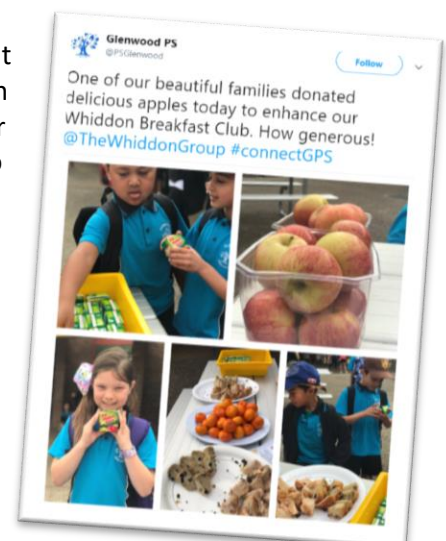
Principal's Message

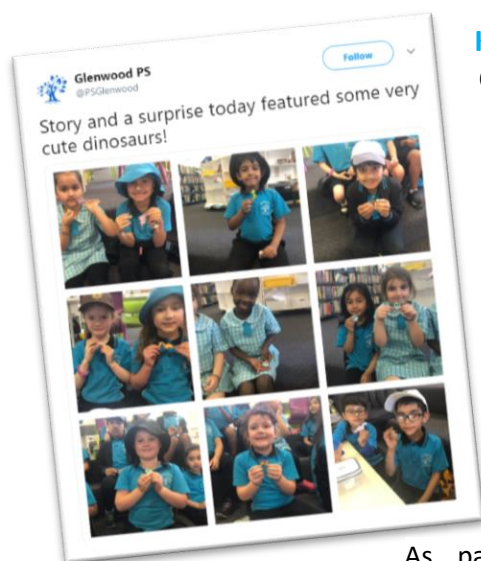

Alternative arrangements have been made by the YMCA and there is an alternative arrangement being coordinated to bus students to and from our school in the morning and afternoon to the nearest YMCA facility located at Sackville Street Public School.

Executive Arrangements for Week 3

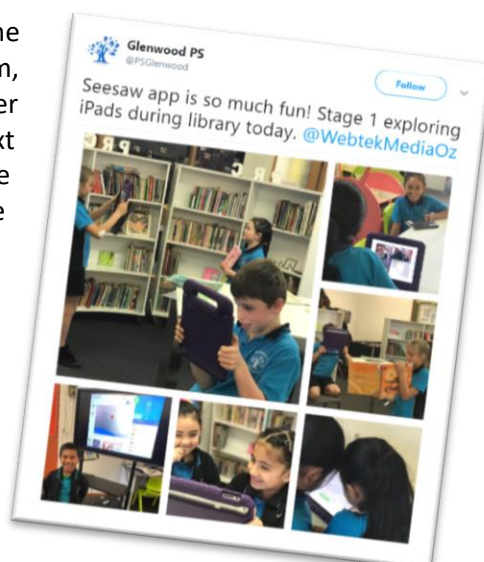

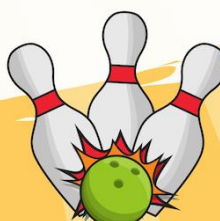
